

The **Duke of Edinburgh's Award** is an award for young people aged 14-25, which is completed through a Licenced Organisation, which in our case is the Scout Association.

Level	Age	Duration	Sections	Expedition
Bronze	14+ / Year 9	6 months	Volunteering, Skill & Physical each for 3 months, one section for 6 months	2 days, 1 night in normal country
Silver	15+ / Year 10	12 months (6 if Bronze complete)	Volunteering - 6 months, Skill & Physical - one for 3 months and the other for 6 months. If Bronze not completed one section must be for 12 months.	3 days, 2 nights in open country
Gold	16+	18 months (12 if Silver complete)	Volunteering - 12 moths, Skill & Physical one for 6 months and the other for 12 months. If Silver not completed, one section must be for 18 months.	4 days, 3 nights in wild country

Four sections (five at Gold)

For each level of award, you need to an activity within each of four sections: volunteering, skill, physical & an expedition. At Gold level you also need to complete a residential project.

Section	Aim	Examples
Volunteering	To make a positive contribution to your community, by helping an individual or an organisation.	There are <u>lots of choices</u> including helping people or animals, leadership, raising awareness, environmental projects or helping a charity.
Skill	To develop practical and social skills and personal interests. Please be careful not to choose a sport as a skill – these can usually be prefixed with 'learning about'.	> There are over 300 different <u>activity ideas</u> you can choose from including: playing an instrument, learning a language, event planning, gliding, marksmanship (shooting) or producing a newsletter or website.
Physical	To participate and show improvement in a sport, dance or fitness activity.	There are <u>lots of choices</u> including team sports, individual sports such as archery, canoeing, climbing, rowing, sailing & walking; or just keeping fit at a gym.
Expedition	To plan, train for and complete an expedition with a purpose.	Your unit or district will probably organise expeditions. At Gold level we run an Open Gold programme. You can also email us if you need an opportunity to complete your expedition.
Residential	To take part in a shared activity away from home for 5 days, 4 nights with people you don't know.	There are a wide range of <u>activity choices</u> , such as training, activity based, environmental or volunteering. You could help at a Scout Campsite or at a camp as a young leader with a unit other that your own.

Frequently asked questions

How do I get started? You need to purchase a participation place by completing the attached form or registering online at <u>www.hsdofe.org</u>.

How do I choose my activity? There is a <u>suggested list of activities</u> you can choose from or even choose you own (check it with us first). You then log your choice of activity on <u>EDofE</u>.

How long do I need to do the activity for? You need to do each activity for an average of an hour per week for the time required. You could do two hours every other week, if it is less often you could do some preparation or other research in between.

How is each activity assessed? You need to find an experienced adult (18+) to assess your activity, except for the expedition section where they need to be a D of E accredited assessor.
